

DENMARK FARM CONSERVATION CENTRE - ECO CAMPSITE GUIDELINES 2014

• Description

The Eco Campsite at Denmark Farm is open from **Fri 11th April** until **Fri 31st October 2014**. Set in a **wonderful, wildlife-rich 40 acre nature reserve**, the campsite is situated on a gently sloping field next to woodland. With almost no light pollution, the stars are amazing too!

We have space for approx 10 two person tent pitches or equivalent, up to a **maximum of 20 adults**. Children aged 10 and below can be in addition to this as long as the overall total of 10 pitches is not exceeded. An **18 foot diameter yurt** is also available for hire as a group space or for sleeping in (max 4 people – bring your own bed/bedding). The Yurt is only available until the **end of September**.

There is a small **kitchen area** next to the campsite, made from sustainably sourced timber, set back within the woodland edge. This is for food preparation and washing up (cold water tap nearby).

The **campsite is not accessible by car** as it is 150 metres from the carpark, via a level tarmac path and then a gentle slope in the field itself. A large barrow/trolley is available to transport equipment.

Toilets and showers are in the Centre, close to the car park, with access via a key pad lock. There are also two compost toilets; one close to the campsite and the other near the car park.

Other considerations

- Tents only - no caravans or campervans allowed on site
- Campervans permitted to park in our carpark overnight (no electric hook up)
- All vehicles to be parked in the carpark
- Guide dogs only on campsite
- No open fires
- 'Quiet Site / please leave no trace' (i.e. no amplified music & remove all waste/refuse)
- Smoking not allowed in yurt, camp kitchen or toilet/shower block
- No electricity available on site

• Other Equipment

The camp kitchen includes a double gas ring, large saucepan, kettle, sink and small storage area. There is no lighting on site - campers need to bring their own torches etc. The yurt (optional hire) includes a large round table (seating 10-12), benches and wood burning stove (firewood provided). Four 6 seat picnic benches are sited externally nearby.

• 2014 Camp Fees

Groups / Families: Sole Occupancy (approx 20 adults/children aged 6-16; plus any children under 6): **£200** per night (includes use of yurt, all camp kitchen facilities, firewok & charcoal). Exclusive bookings ensure that no other campers are on site for the period reserved and dogs may be allowed by prior arrangement. Wood is provided for the stove.

Individuals: Adults (16+): **£10** ppn / Children ages 6-15: **£5** ppn / Children ages 0-5 : **Free**

Denmark Farm Course Participants: **£10** ppn (includes use of campsite and indoor facilities).

Yurt Hire: for communal daytime use, not sleeping: **£45** per day, wood for stove provided.

Yurt Hire: for overnight use: **£45** per night, sleeps max 4 people, wood for stove provided.

• Additional Use of Dormitories for Groups

14 beds are available for hire in the main building in 3 dormitories as follows: 2-bed, 7-bed en suite, & 5 bed. **£15** ppn includes bed linen and use of self catering kitchen. No equipment from the Centre may be taken out to the campsite. 3 star self-catering accommodation is also available.

• Bookings & Arrivals (strictly pre-paid, advance bookings only)

Booking forms need to be completed and returned **with full payment** no later than one week before arrival date. Full details of site layout, key pad code and other logistics will be sent on receipt of payment. **Arrivals should be before 7pm**, unless arranged in advance, to avoid disturbance to other campers and to farmhouse tenants, who live adjacent to the car park.
